

Overview

The Women's Health Care Event at the Leamington weCHC site provided high-impact access to primary care, cancer screening, and diagnostic services for new clients, migrant workers, and refugee women facing significant barriers to care.

Key Outcomes

Primary Care Attachment & Access

- **127 clients** attached to primary care -- 43 additional came to clinic – on wait list
- **90% required full translation services**

Diagnostics & Lab Services

- **419 blood, urine and swabs samples** processed—despite no Sunday lab access in Leamington – strong partnership with lab company allowed this to be successful
- Testing included bloodwork, urine testing, and cervical swabs
- Positive diagnoses of STIs and one urgent diabetes diagnosis were subsequently treated by the CHC

Cancer Screening

- **111 HPV tests completed**
- **23 mammograms** completed through Erie Shores HealthCare

Oral Health Services

- **10 clients** received preventive dental cleaning through Smile Wagon

Training & Education

- **9 medical learners** from U of W and Western learned women's wellness!
- Students reported increased confidence and skill
- **No clients refused** student participation during exams
