This position is responsible for a range of health promotion activities that engage community members in understanding and addressing the social determinants of health. The Health Promoter designs and implements health promotion strategies, coordinates wellness programs, conducts community needs assessments and is actively engaged with stakeholders including municipalities, politicians, and regional/provincial partners regarding health projects. This position is also a key advocate for healthy public policies.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Master's degree in health promotion, community development, community psychology, social work, OR a bachelor's degree with significant experience in health promotion required.
- Certification in program evaluation or community engagement preferred.
- 3–5 years in health promotion/community development, including 1–2 years in community health settings preferred.
- Proficiency in group facilitation, advocacy, and program evaluation, and experience working with seniors and diverse populations required.
- Strong interpersonal skills, solutions-focused, compassionate required.
