We are looking for **people with stroke** or their **family members** from the **Black/African community** to take part in our study.

### PARTICIPANTS NEEDED



We are researchers at the University of Toronto looking for people from the Black/African community to take part in a research study on health and social services for people after stroke. You could help us understand what supports people and their families need to get better after stroke. The research study is called ‘Breaking down the “one-size-fits-all” approach to poststroke services through an in-depth understanding of the poststroke experiences and needs of individuals from South Asian, Chinese and Black ethnic groups’. This project uses a technique called photovoice where participants will take photos to express their experiences after stroke.

Joining the study means that you would have:

- 3 individual meetings (~1-hour each) and
- 1 group meeting (2-hours)
