

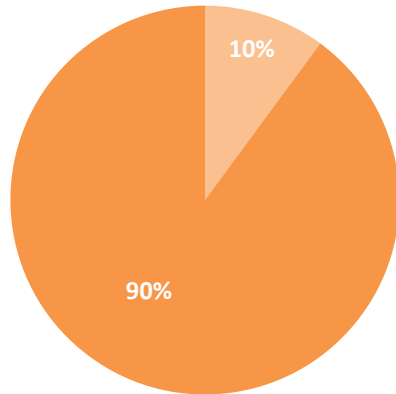

In comparison to national and provincial data*, the member sample showed:

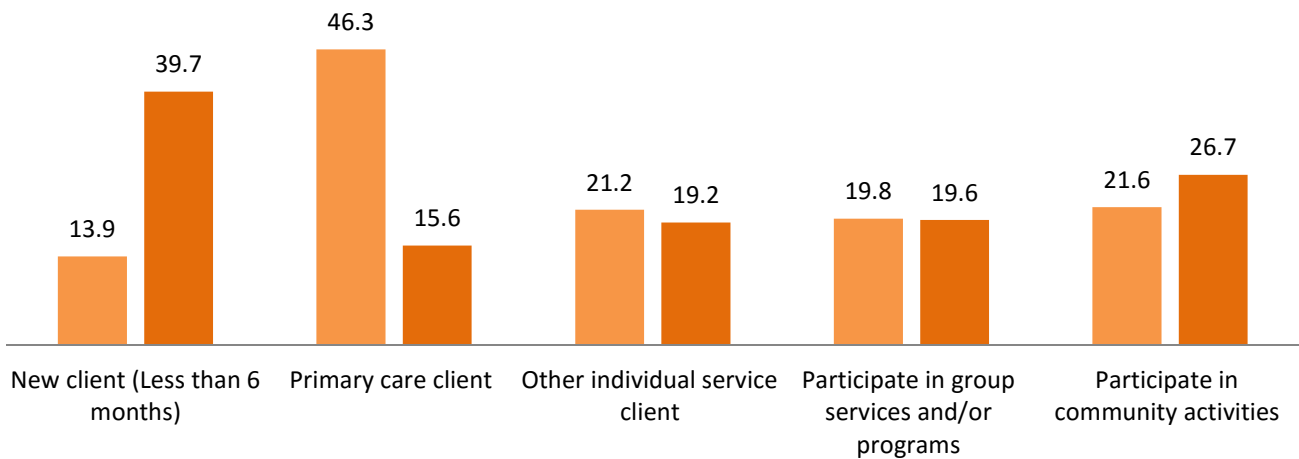
- Fewer social contacts

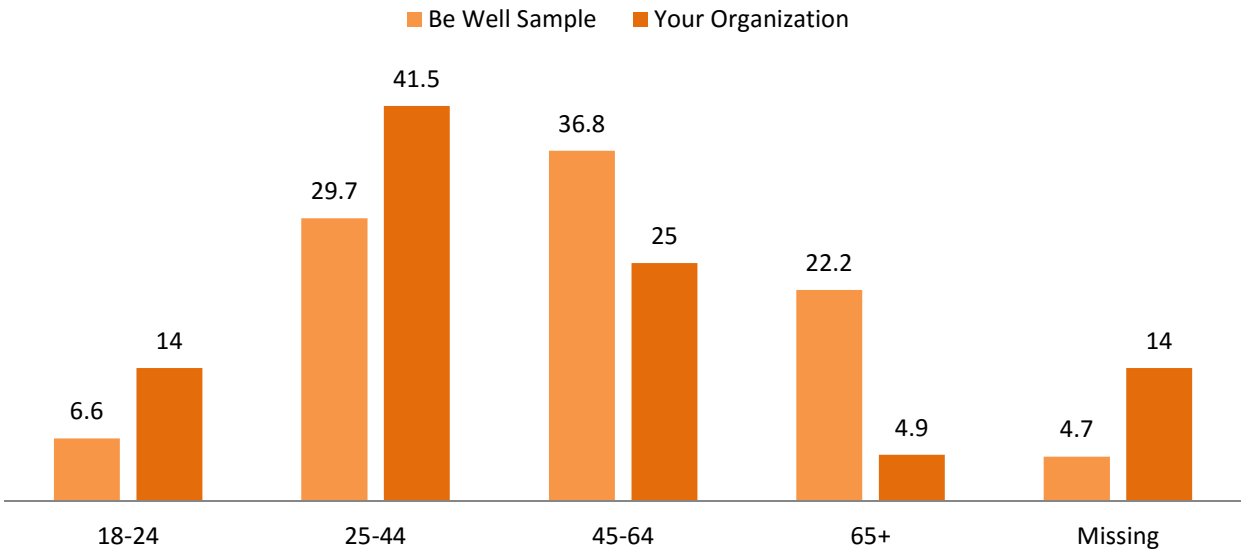

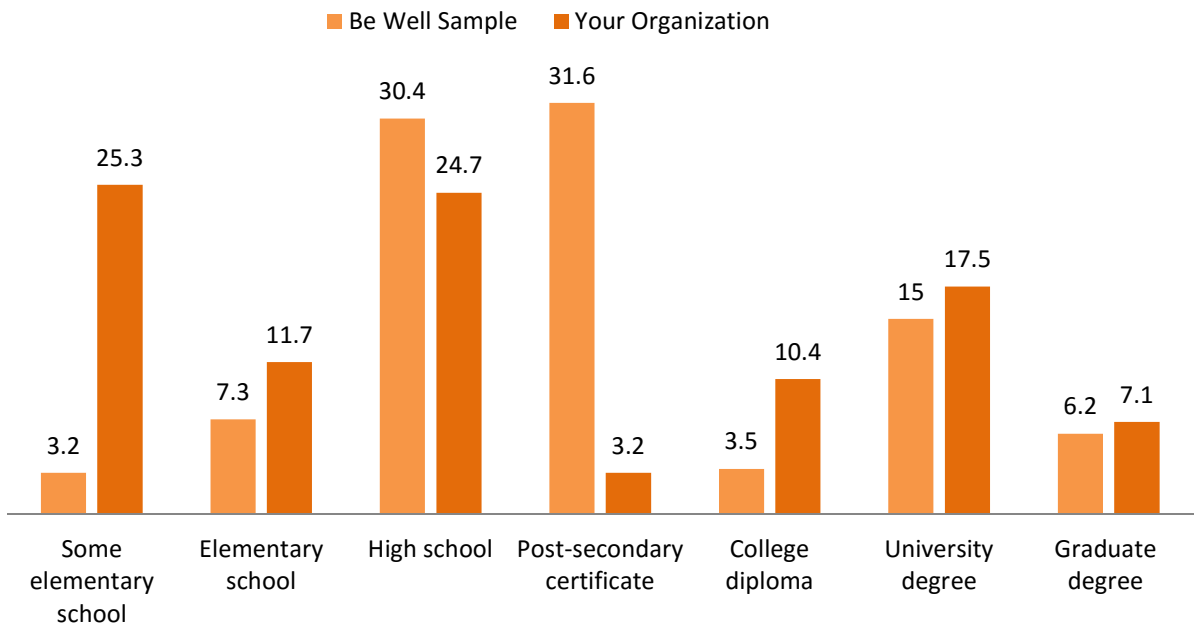

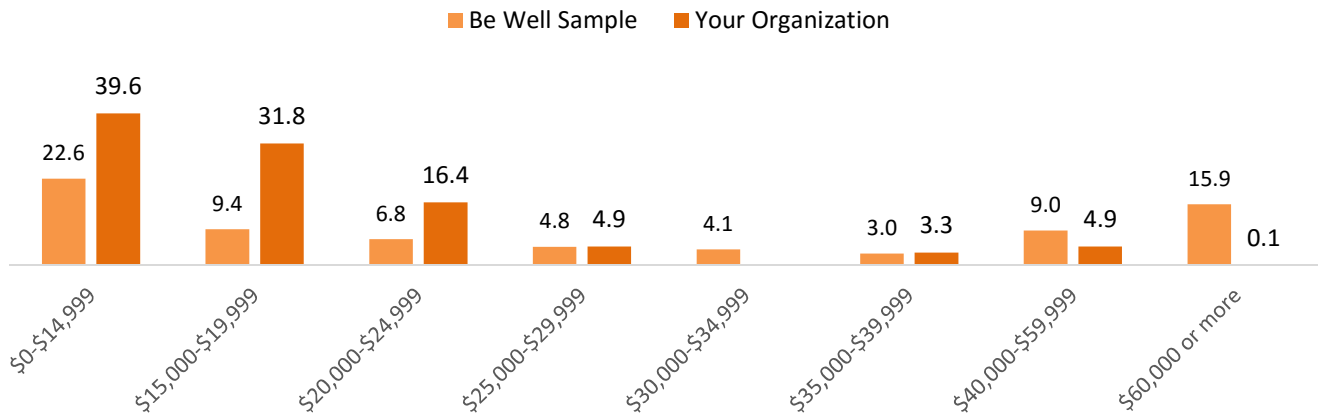

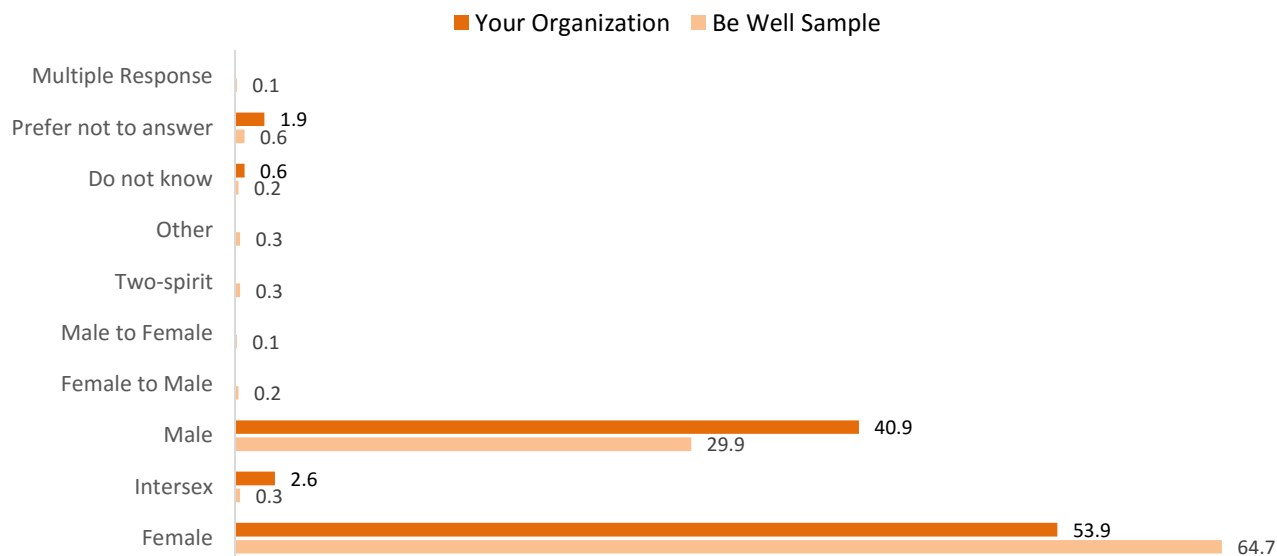

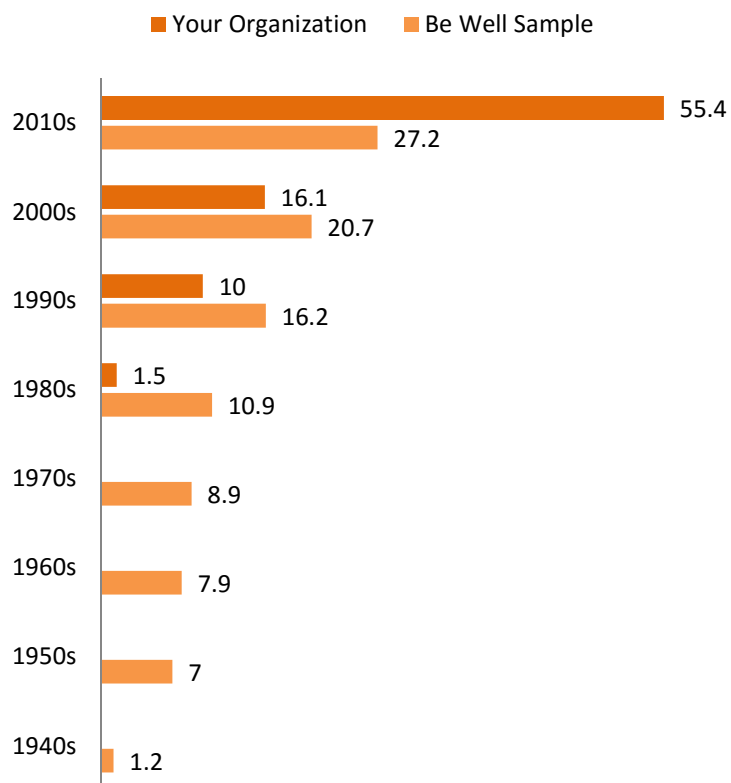
Self-Identified racial/ethnic identity (percent)



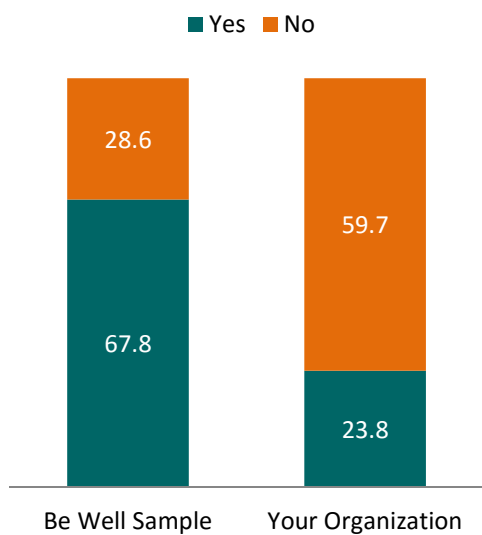
Gender (percent)



Decade Arrived in Canada (percent)



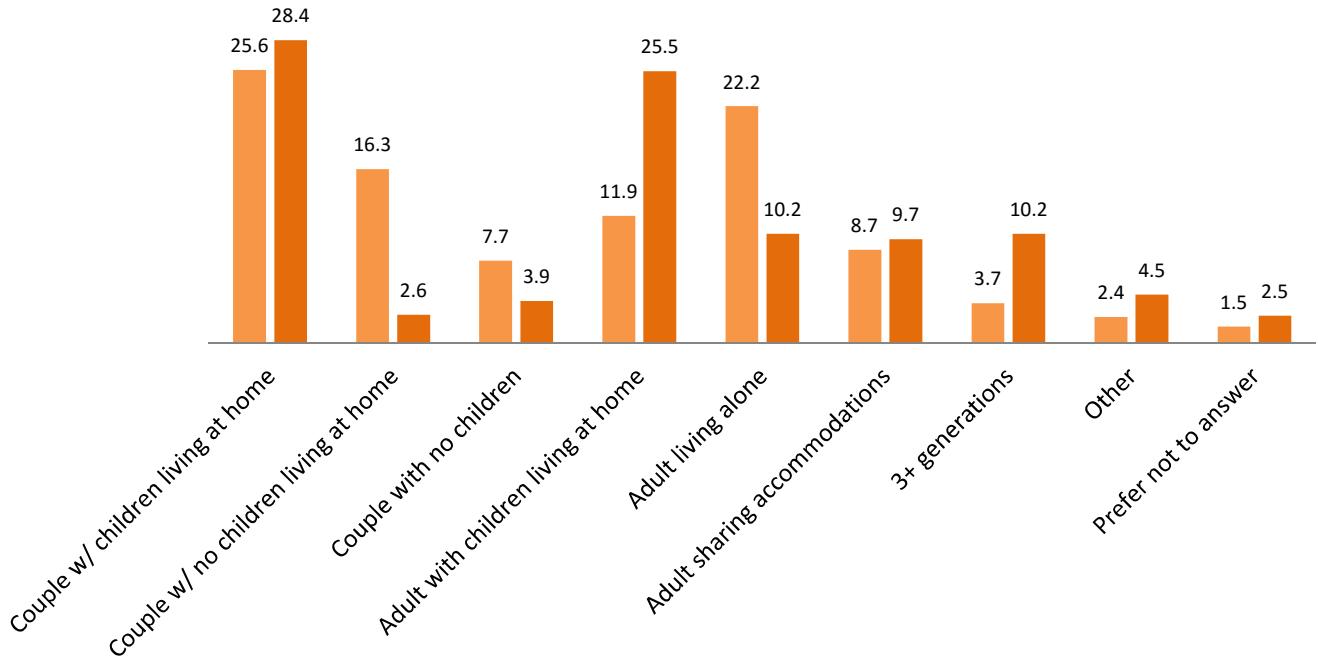
Were you Born in Canada (percent)

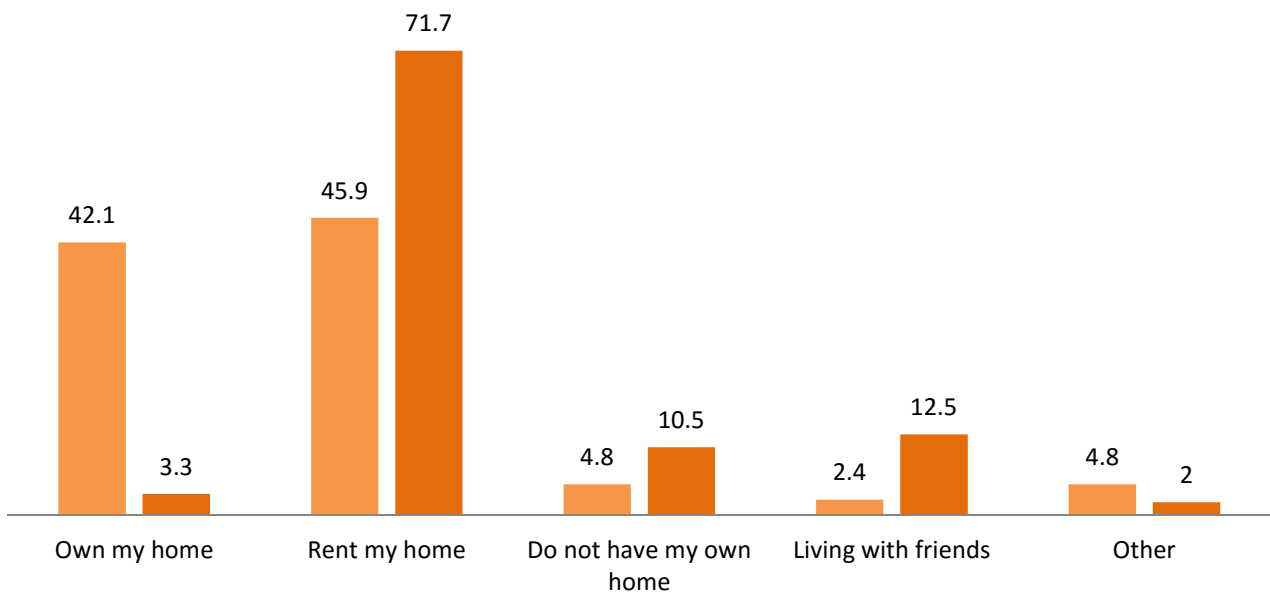

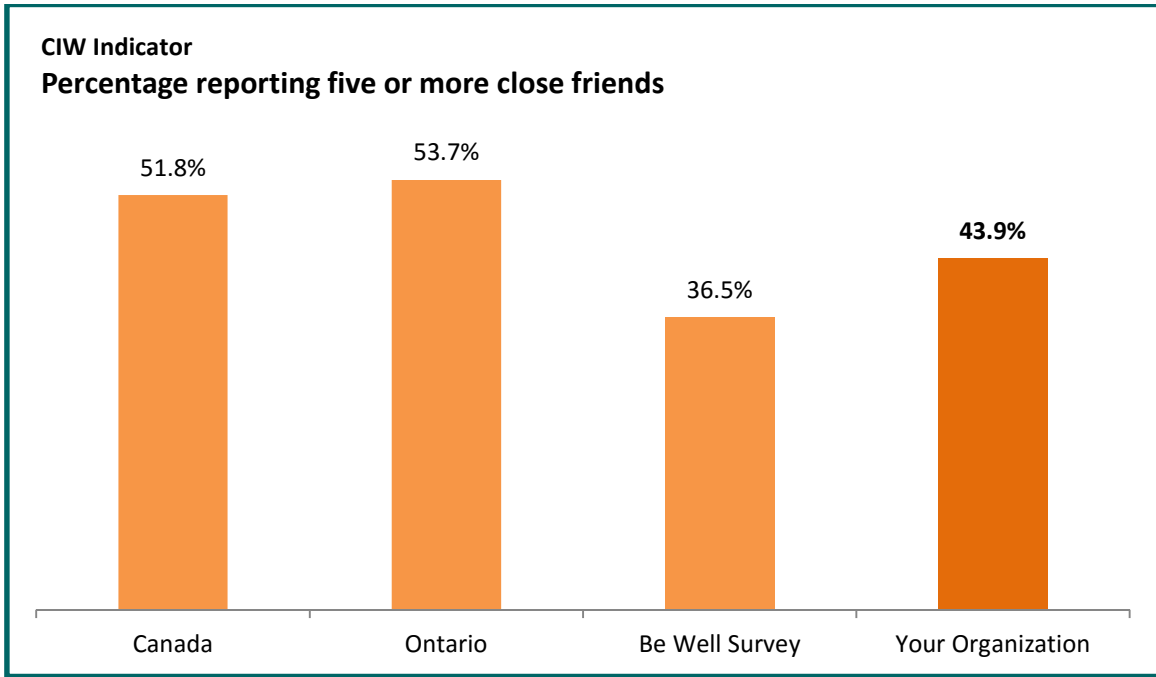

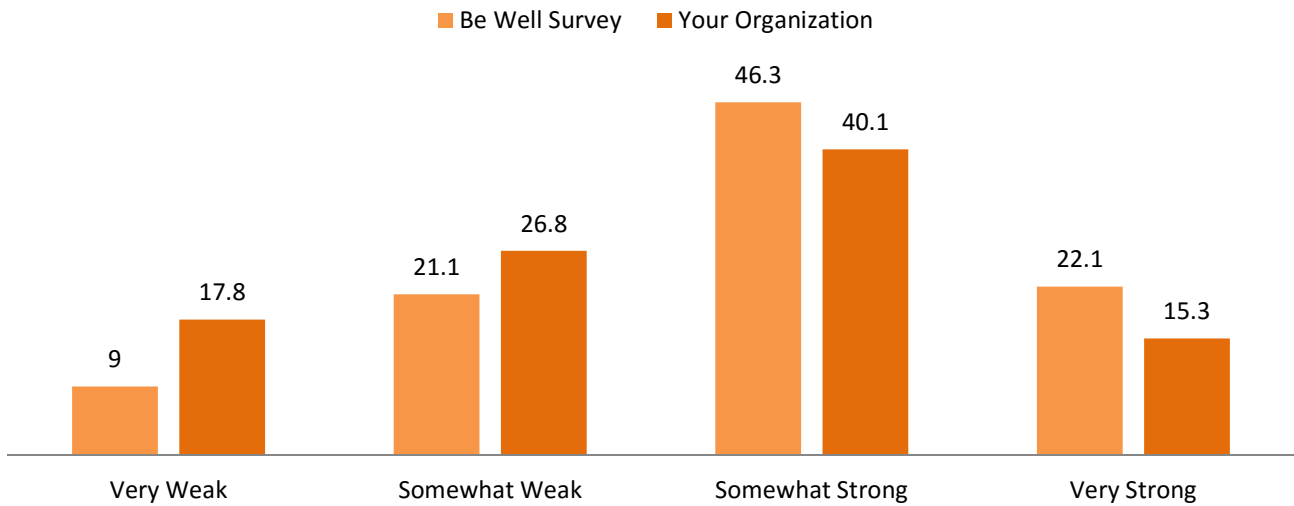

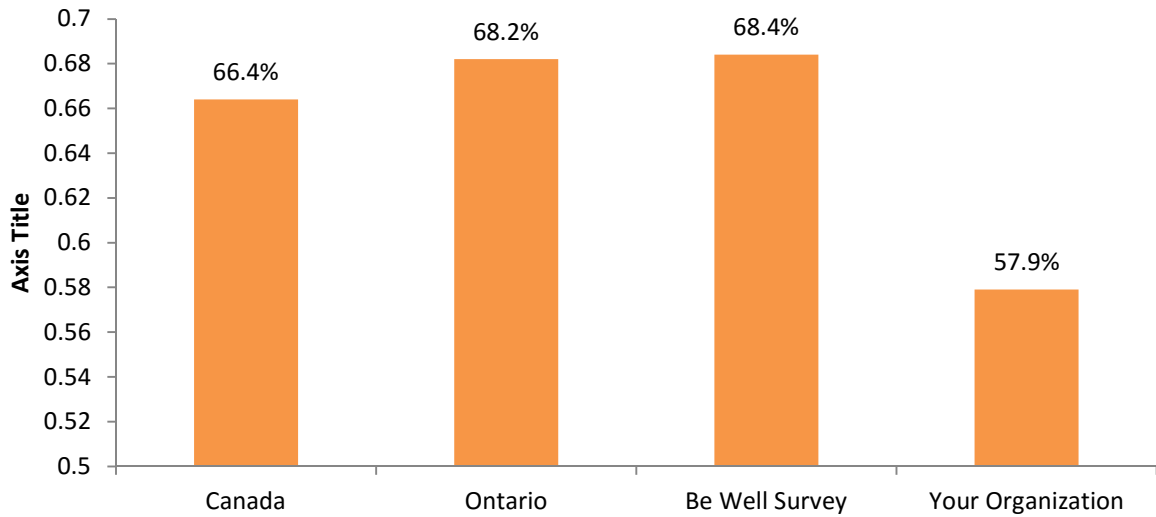
Number of Social Contacts



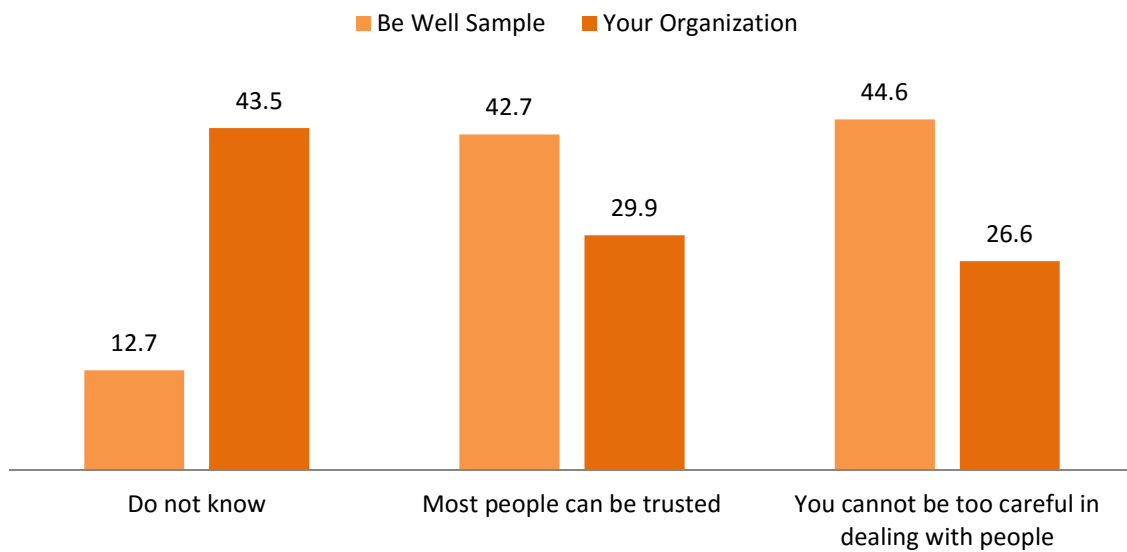
Sense of Belonging (percent)

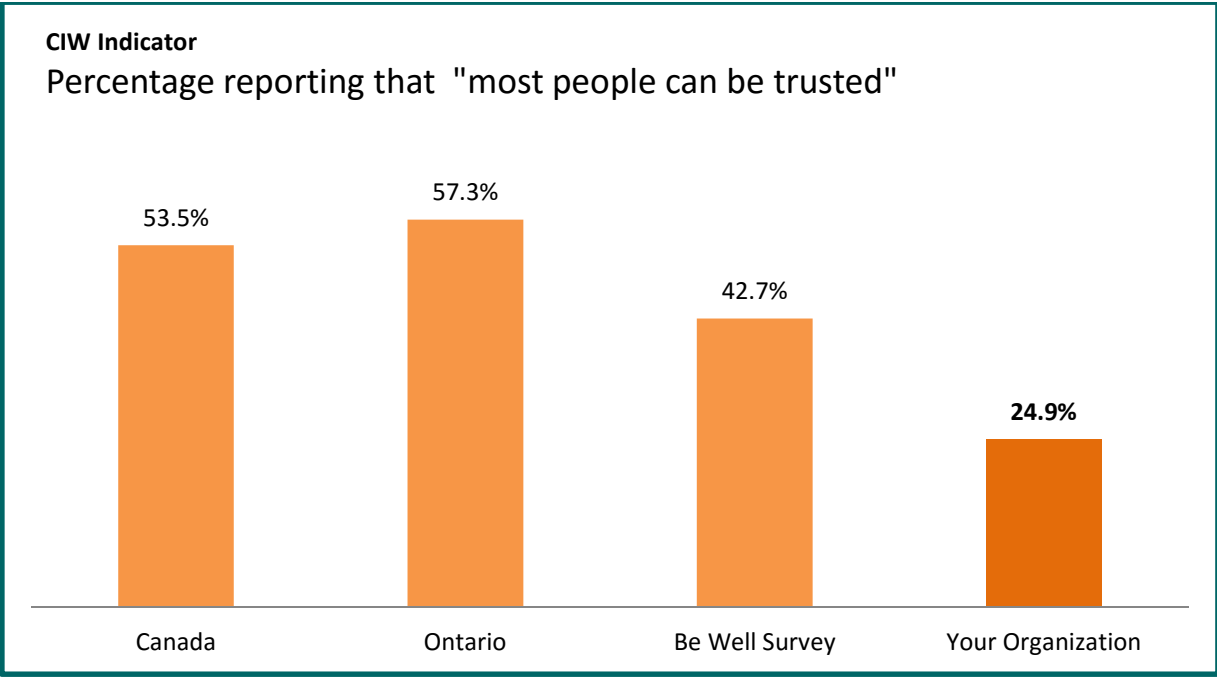

sense of community belonging

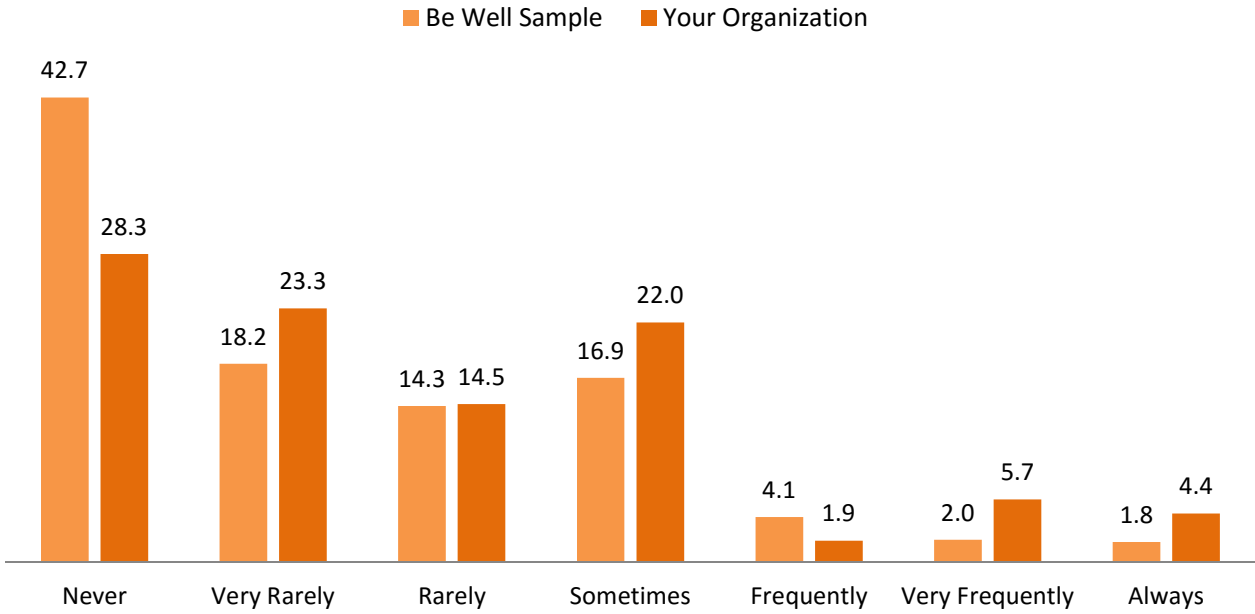


Sense of Trust
 (percent)



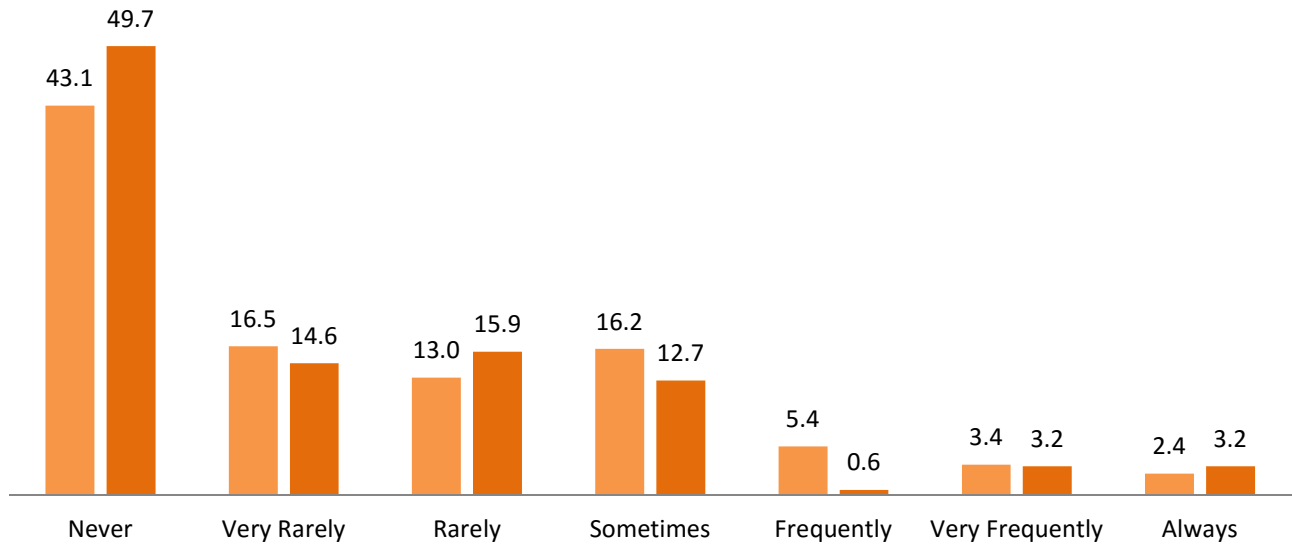

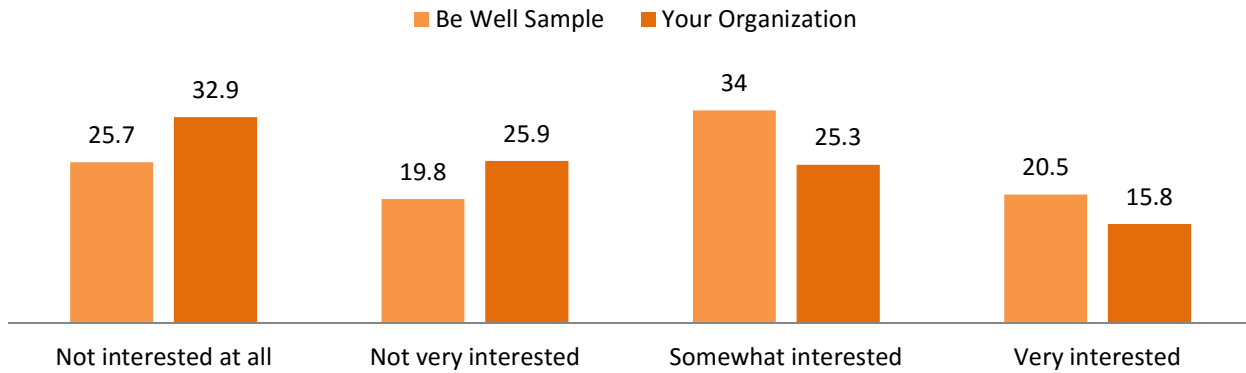

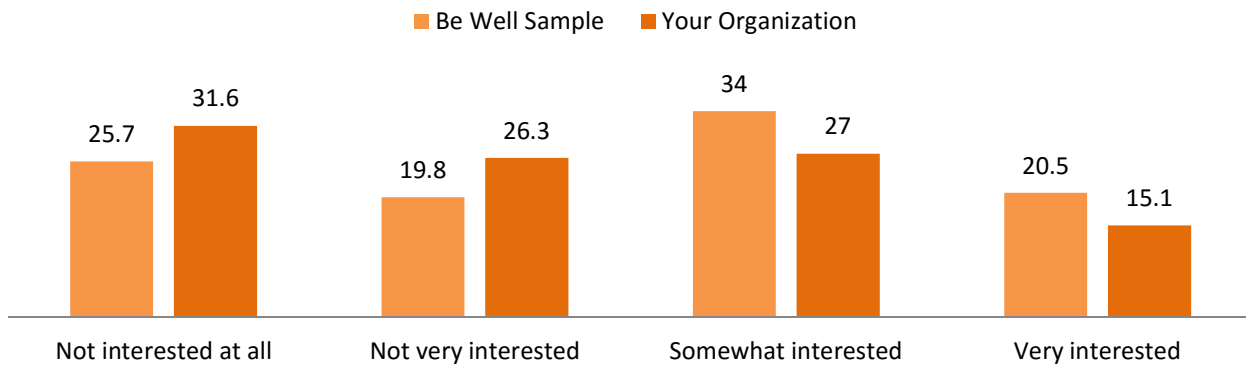

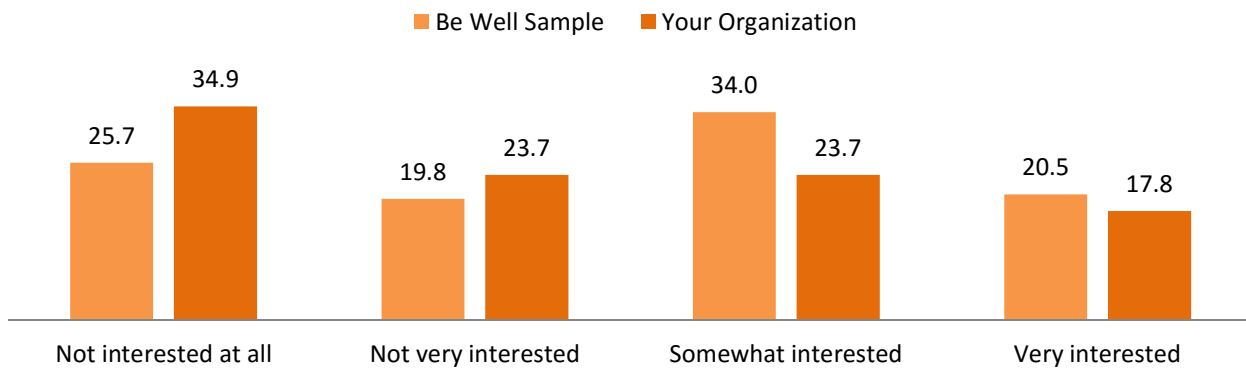
Interest in Federal Politics (percent)



Interest in Provincial Politics (percent)

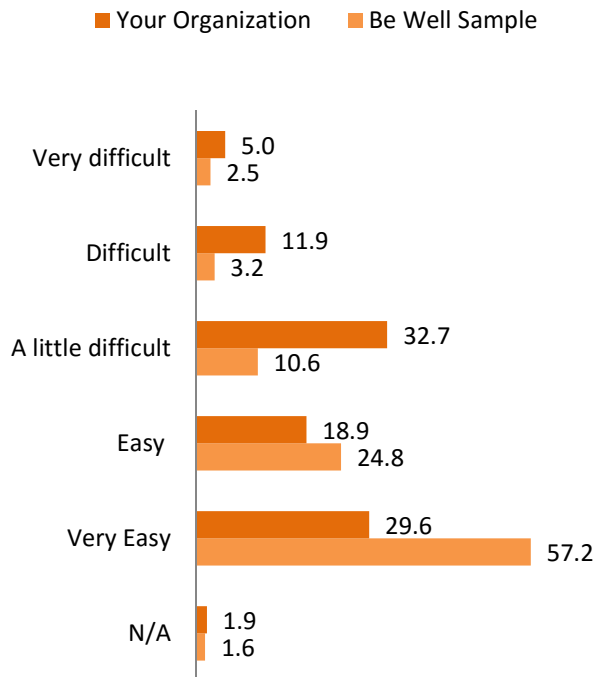


Interest in Municipal Politics (percent)

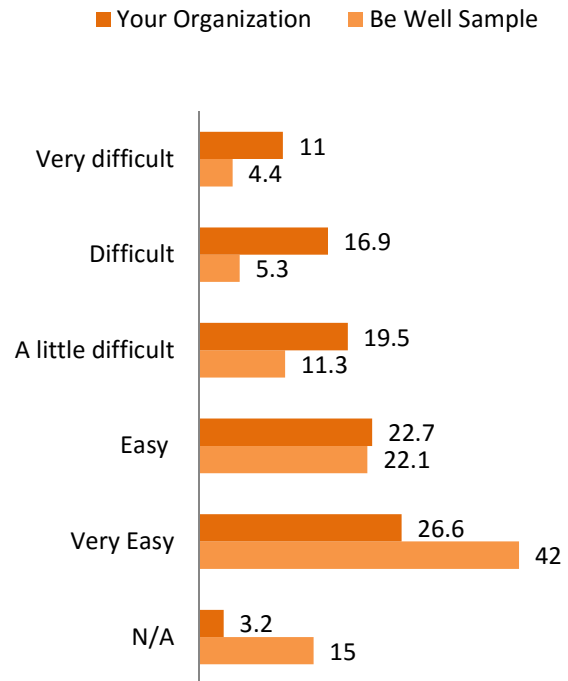

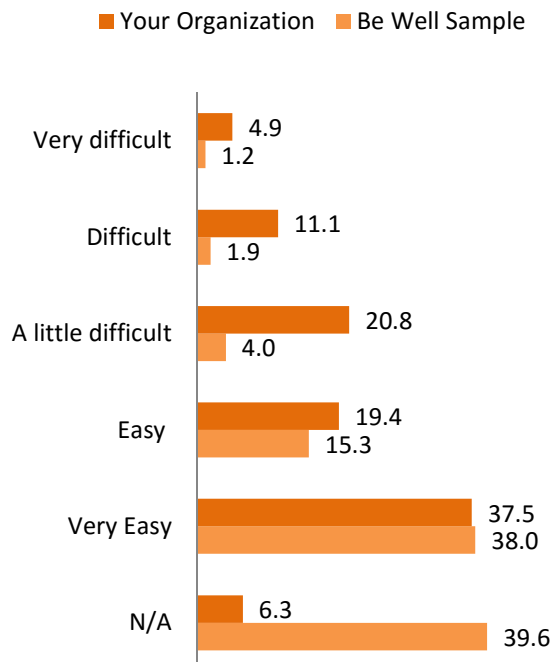

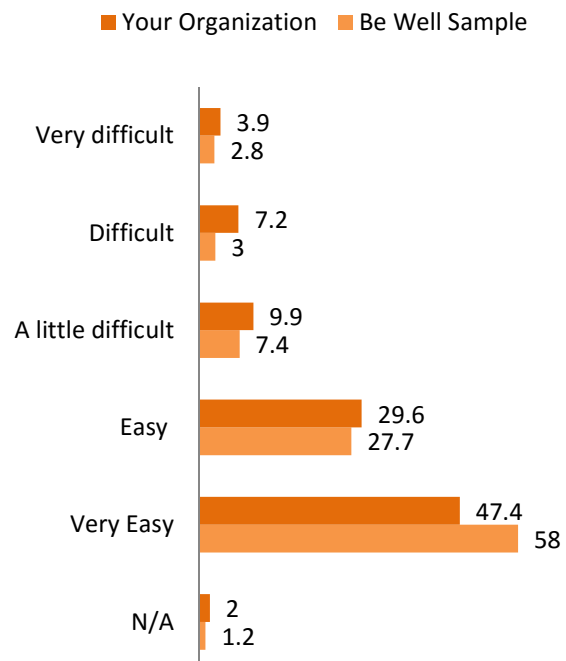

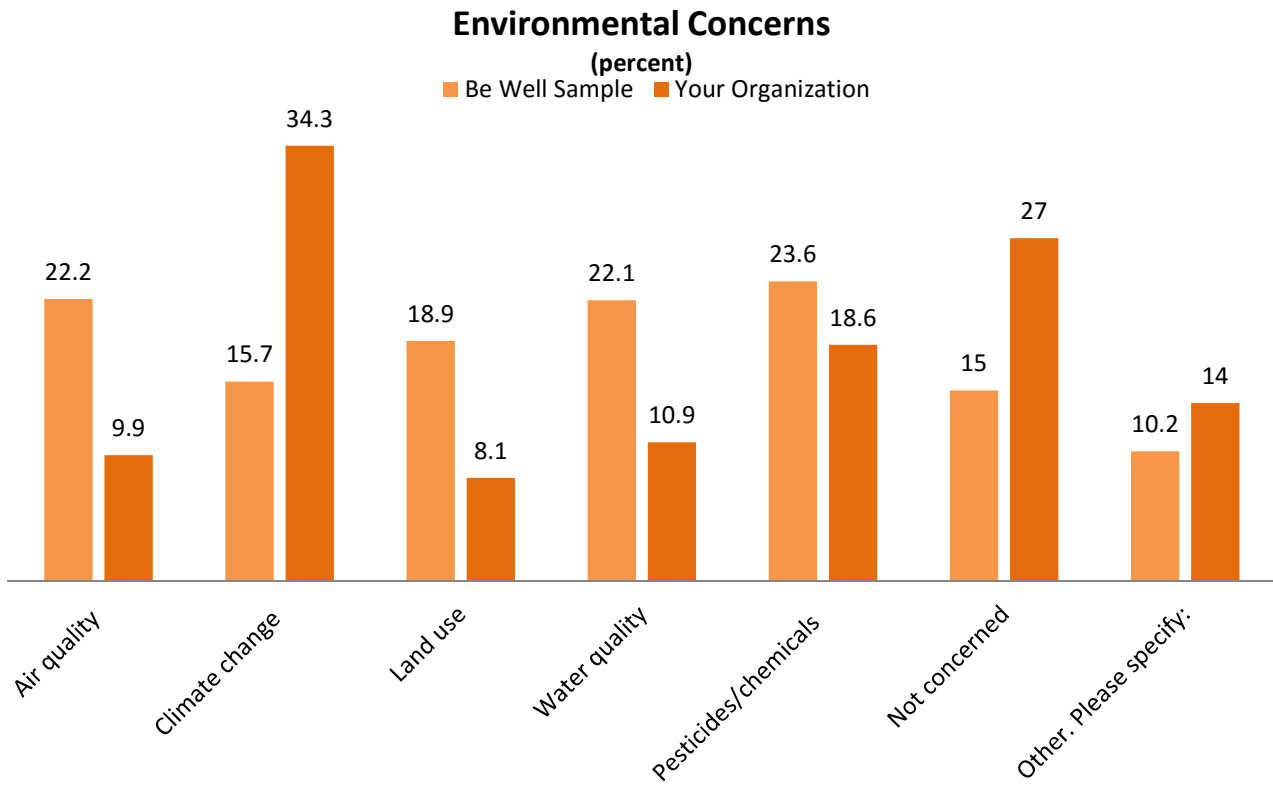

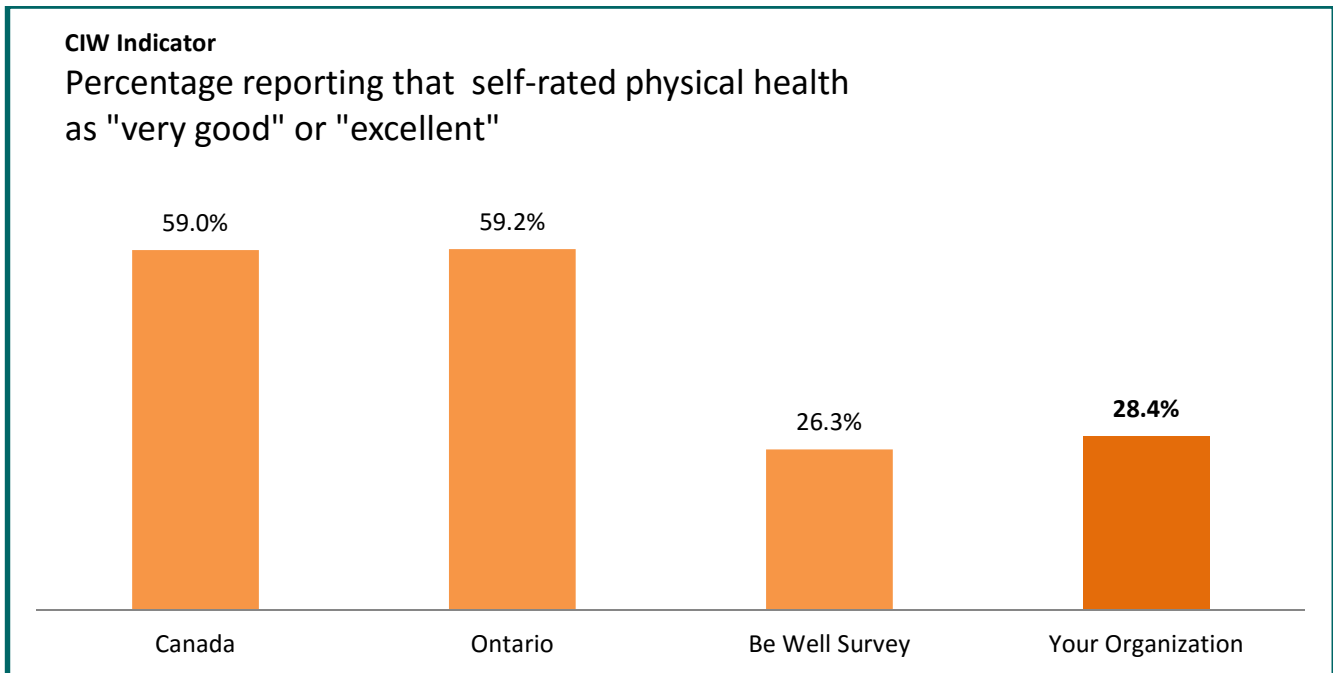

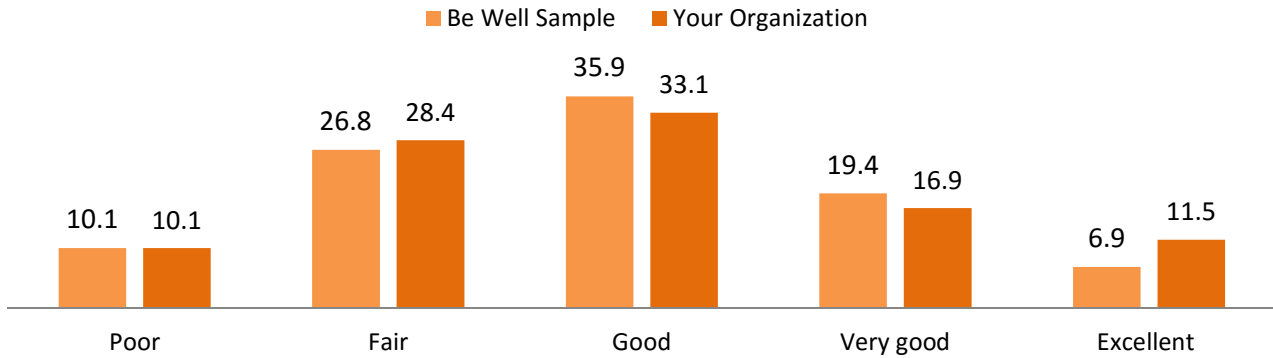

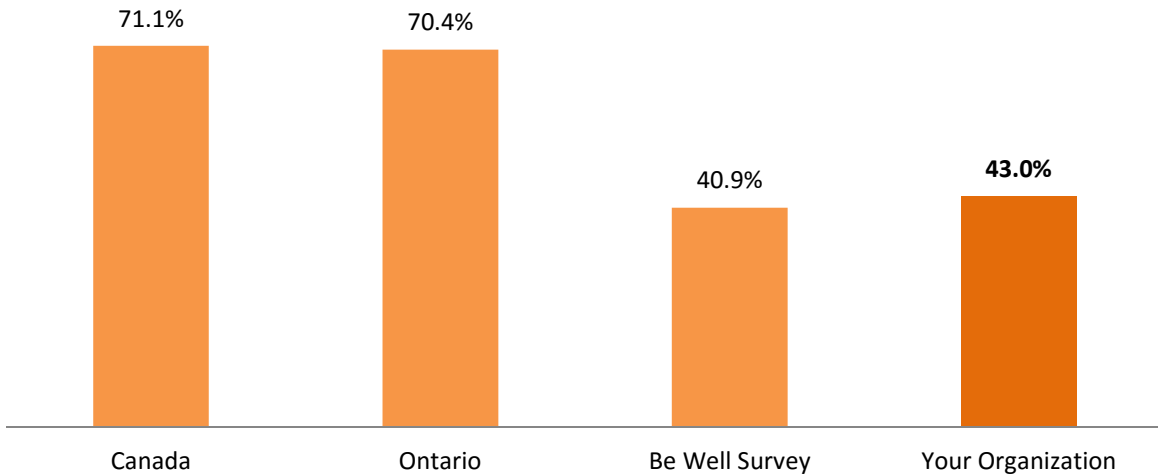


Self-assessed physical health (percent)

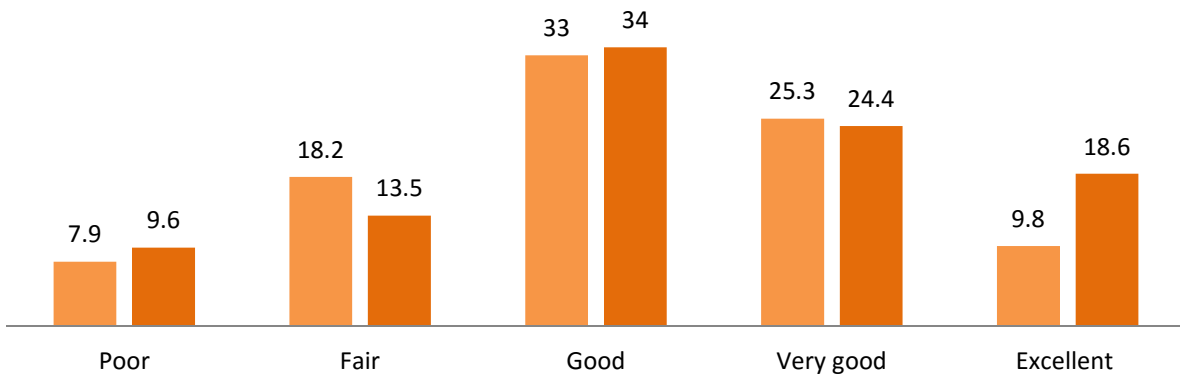

Percentage reporting that self-rated mental health as "very good" or "excellent"

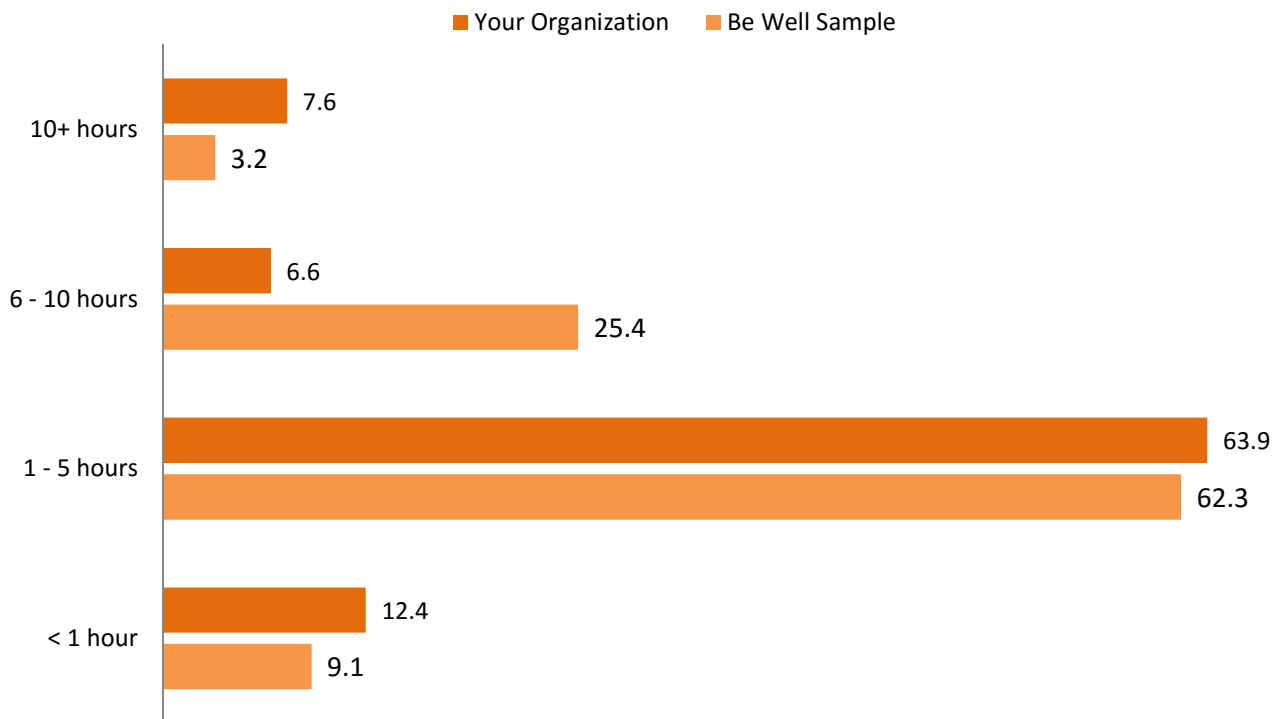


Self-assessed mental health (percent)



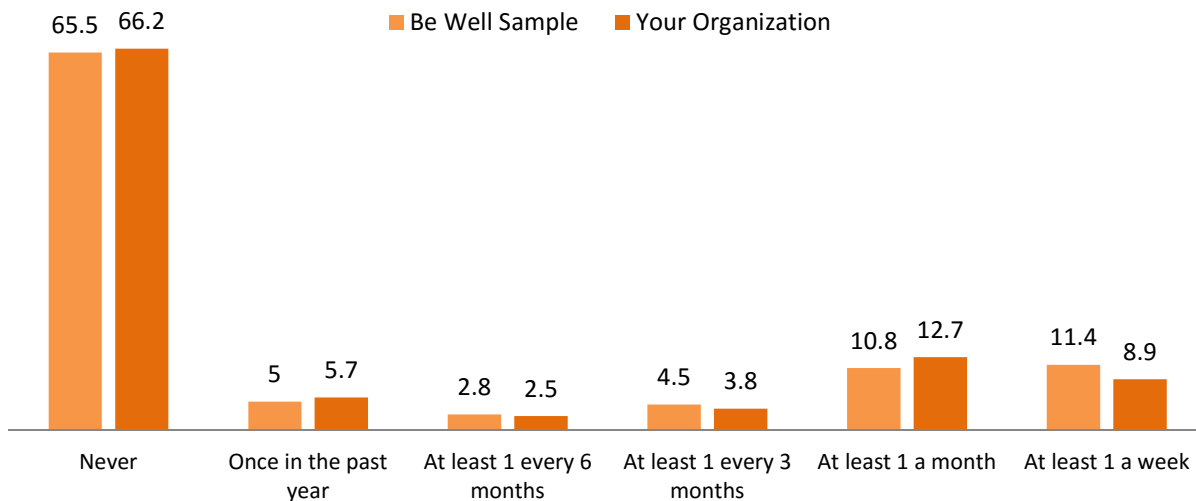

(percent)

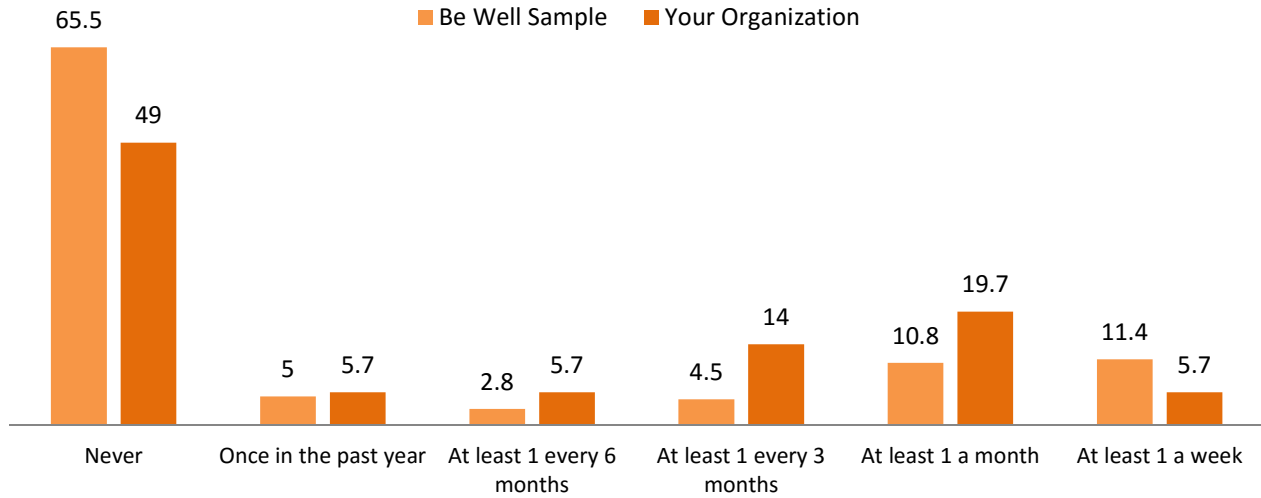

(percent)

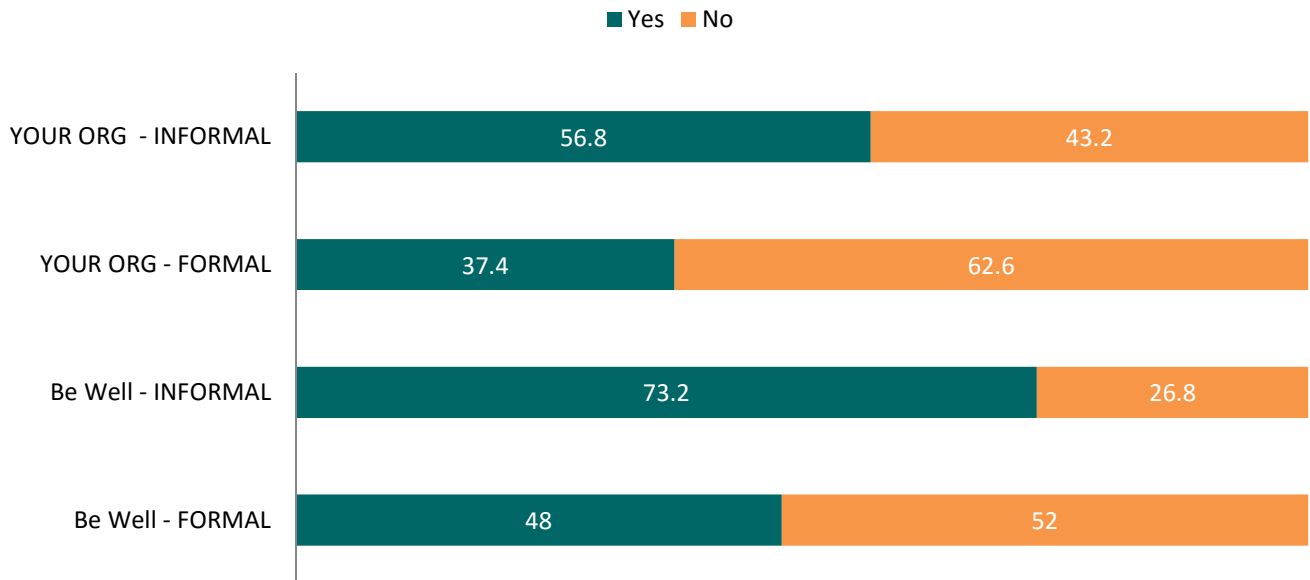


Economic Security Concerns: Difficulty making ends meet (percent)



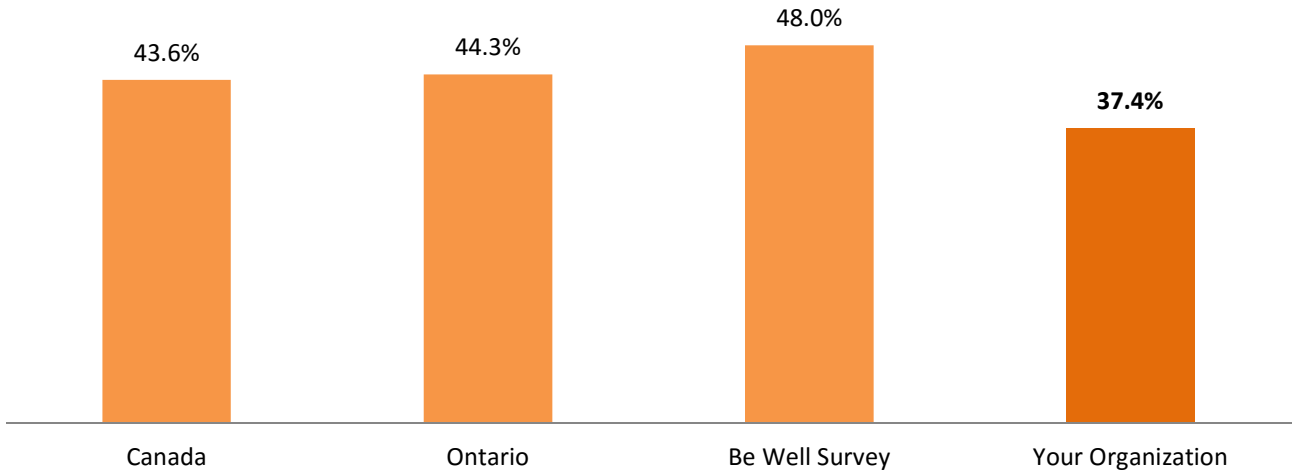
