What is the purpose of this learning collaborative?

A learning collaborative is a short-term learning system that **brings teams together to seek improvement in a focused topic area, in this case, the collection of sociodemographic data.** Alliance members have always had a commitment to equity, which includes a **commitment to collecting and using sociodemographic data.** In 2020, Alliance members unanimously resolved to reach a 75% sociodemographic data completion rate across the sector by 2024.

Benefits of joining:

What's involved?

- Regular **meetings with your QI team.**
- Attending **learning and sharing sessions.**
- **Monthly data pulls** for learning.
- **Engaging with your QI coach.**

Time commitment:

Approximately **40 hours over 12 months**, which includes participation in the above sessions, individual team meetings (including coaching) and homework.
